

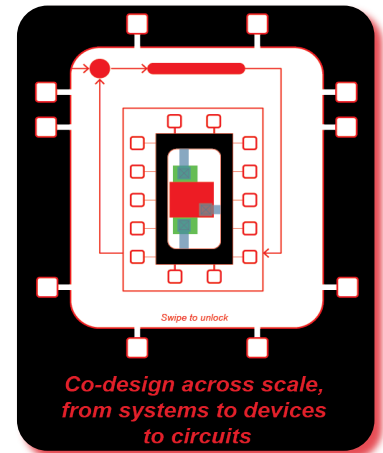

Call for Late Breaking Research Papers DEADLINE: 5/5/26

The 2026 IEEE Midwest Symposium on Circuits and Systems is now accepting **original, unpublished, LATE BREAKING NEWS** papers describing preliminary research in circuits and systems. Prospective authors are invited to submit a full paper (4 page limit, two-column format) describing new research in any area of Circuits and Systems. Sufficient work must have been completed to indicate viability of the thesis presented in the paper, but by their nature **LATE BREAKING NEWS** papers typically outline new and exciting results.



LATE BREAKING NEWS papers will be presented at a poster session, however, both poster and lecture formats have the same value, and presentation method is chosen for suitability.
