Proposals should be limited to two pages with a one-page description of the workshop and a one-page professional biography of the workshop speakers.

The workshop description should include:

- The length of the workshop session (half or full day)
- The motivation and overall goal of the workshop and scope of presentations
- An abstract breakdown of the workshop syllabus including goals, timing, and presentation format for each item
- Overview of the participant experience (lecture, interactive, hands on, etc.)
- List of special equipment required, if any
- Sponsorship information if applicable
